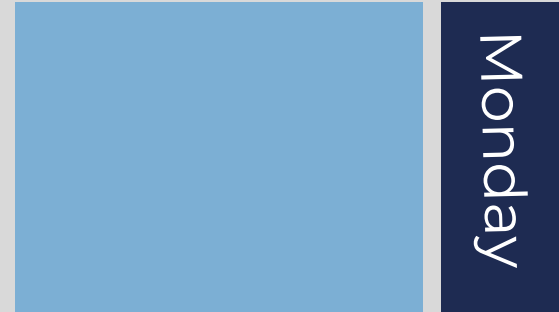


Students, Please DO NOT throw snowballs. This includes during bus drop off and pick up, or any other time you are out doors at school. Thank you!

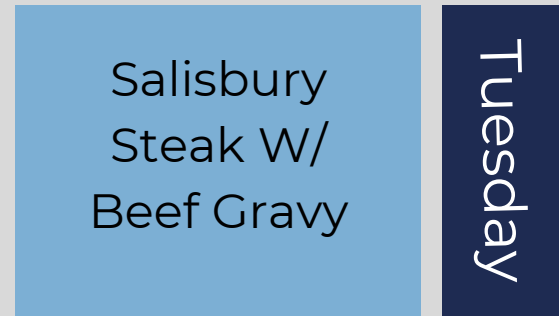
